ATTACHING SNOW CHAINS TO YOUR VEHICLE





Hold chains up and remove any twists so they hang freely. Ensure the **black band** is on the bottom hoop with the open end facing the wheel.



Place chains on the ground facing the wheel. Slide chains around behind the wheel.



Locate the hook and chain at the end of the chain loops. These are marked with multi-coloured washers.



Lift the hook and chain around the wheel and connect together at the **top rear** of the tyre.



Start rolling both plastic hoops **anticlockwise** around the wheel. Rotate both plastic hoops together at the same time.



Keep rotating both plastic hoops around the wheel until the **black band** sits at the **top front** of the tyre.



Shuffle the chains around the tyre so they sit squarely on the tyre and then tighten the chains around the wheel. Adjust the inside hook first **then the front lever.**



Tighten the ratchet and cam lever, once the chains are tight secure the lever under the **side loop** along with any excess chain. Move vehicle forward 10m and re-tighten the chains until **very tight**.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

DO NOT EXCEED 20KPH

CHAINS MUST BE FITTED TIGHTLY

ACCELERATE AND DECELERATE SLOWLY

ONLY FIT CHAINS WHEN THERE IS SNOW COVERING THE ROAD OR WHEN INSTRUCTED

FIT CHAINS TO THE DRIVING WHEELS
